ELECTRICITY SUPPLY CORPORATION OF MALAWI LIMITED

Electricity Act No. 22 of 2004

Notification of intention to Construct a 132kV Transmission Power Line (Kanzimbe to Nanjoka Substation - Salima District)

In accordance with section 39 of the Electricity Act, No. 22 of 2004, notice is hereby given that the Electricity Supply Corporation of Malawi Limited (ESCOM), through JCM Matswani Solar Corporation, intends to construct a 132kV transmission overhead power line (hereinafter called "the line") from Kanzimbe village to Nanjoka substation in Salima district.

1. Particulars of the line are as follows

Length: 4 Km

Way leave width: 30 meters (15 meters going either side from the center of the line)

Voltage: 132kV (132,000 volts)

2. Description

In Kanzimbe Village, the power line starts from the southern tip of the Solar farm, moving parallel to ESCOM's existing 132kV overhead line from Nanjoka to Chintheche, and then goes south eastwards until it crosses the road to Mbwezera Full Primary School (i.e. the road that joins the M5 road) before it turns southwards at an angle of about 130 degrees, passing through Kanzimbe, Malezi, and Mtolo villages. It then continues into Waya Village until it crosses the road to Sadzu Trading Centre and then crosses the railway line at a distance of 700 meters, passing through

Serenity Acres Farm and then turns south-eastwards to avoid buildings before it moves southwards again, crossing Odimba River, passing through Santhe and Sadzu villages, still parallel to the existing 132kV overhead line, and finally terminates into the existing Nanjoka substation.

Any owner, lessee, or occupier over whose land the intended line passes, is informed that plans for construction are available for inspection at ESCOM's planning offices in Blantyre, Lilongwe and Mzuzu. Route plans can be inspected at Salima District Commissioner and District Council's offices at anytime during normal business hours from 07:30 a.m. to 04:30 p.m.

Notice is further given that objections by any owner, lessee or occupier of land affected by the intended Transmission line must be served on ESCOM in writing within 30 days from the date hereof at the offices of ESCOM.
